

Join Joni for a day of creative fun making stained glass quilts "the easy way". Choose your project at the guild meeting and then purchase your pattern at Kindred Spirits. You can also have a kit assembled. Bring it to life! We will spend the day selecting and preparing fabric for fusing and getting the quilt top ready for quilting. Sewing machines are not required.

Class preparation:

Please come to class with your chosen design traced on your black fabric "right way" and, if possible, once on your fusible (reversed). If you have a large light table or window you should be able to trace the design through the black fabric with a chalk pencil. You can use pencil or pen to trace the reversed design on the fusible. We will start the day cutting apart the fusible and selecting fabrics to fill in the picture, then moving on to fusing the pieces down.

Supply List:

- Select your project and bring a selection of fabrics and the fusible web supplies listed on the pattern
- Fine point sharpie marker and chalk pencil/marker
- Zip lock bags to keep track of pieces and a garbage bag for the extra bits
- Sharp scissors (medium and large if you have both)
- Mini-Iron or Iron and ironing mat
- No sewing machine required
- Lunch
